At the end of December, we had a total of **200 girls up from 84 in November** as **116 new girls** arrived in December 2020.

BUTIAMA SAFE HOUSE -

We had a total number of **224 girls in December 2020 up from 100 in November** as 124 new girls arrived.

HEALTH ISSUES

Health check-up conducted to girls who arrived and departure in both safe houses, this conducted in collaboration with police gender desk and social welfare. All girls had health check. Health services were provided to all children whom found with health problems after check up to the hospital. Counselling sessions conducted to all girls.

VILLAGE ISSUES

The seasonal cutting started girls fled from FGM and rescued from community in Serengeti, Butiama and Tarime, the rescue was done in collaboration with Police gender desks in Serengeti and Butiama. All 12 clans perform the cutting.

LEGAL ISSUES

4 rape cases continue in Butiama, 9 Cases in Serengeti, all cases continue in Serengeti, Bunda and Butiama. One case was completed in Serengeti, where the father of Jane Mapinduzi was taken to prison for 30 years. 3 new FGM cases opened at court in the seasonal cutting of 2020/2021.

GIRLS RESCUE CAMP

Different programmes were conducted during the seasonal cutting in Butiama safe house and Hope Mugumu Safe house, where total of 424 were involved in the programme as follows: -

- Tuition for Primary and Secondary school
- · Reading and writing class
- · Life skills Tailoring, batik making
- · Counselling
- · Legal education
- · Reproductive health education
- The effects of GBV
- Identifying traditions and customs which violate girls and women rights
- · Psychosocial support



ITEMS PROCURED

During the seasonal cutting the following items were purchased after deficit to the safe house as follows:

Bar soap, maize flour, cooking oil, bedsheets, mattress, blankets, cups, plates, exercise books, pens, underwear, sandels, clothes, tooth paste, tooth brushes, beans, firewood, body oil, ream papers, mosquito repellents, salts, sugar, sanitary pads, buckets, dustbins, wheat flour, meat, mosquito nets etc.





SUPPORT AND AID

FOUR SEASONS:

We have received food and sanitary items aid from four seasons on December, the items received include. Including rice 150 kg, Beans 50 kg, Maize flour 150 kg, Cooking oil 20 liters, and Girls pads 5 pc. Aslo 8 girls were invited to visit Fourseasons hotel and manage to sing with Fourseasons staff in the Christmas day, we received 5 cups from Fourseasons
