VILLAGE ISSUES

(Any incidents reported, rumors, upcoming cutting etc.)

The seasonal cutting ended, no any new information about cutting.

LEGAL ISSUES

3 rape cases continue in Butiama while 1 case get end [The perpetrator was sentenced for 30 years], 5 Cases in Serengeti, 3 cases get at end the perpetrators were taken to prison 3 new FGM cases opened at court in the seasonal cutting of 2020/2021.

FORMAL EDUCATION AND VTC.

Hope for Girls and Women in Tanzania has managed to send girls to continue with their primary, secondary, High school, Vocational classes and continue with reading and writing class. Total of 37 joined tailoring class [Nine graduated from VTC] and Entrepreneurship where 3 girls continue with Hotel management and Hospitality. Total of 31 girls joined and continue with their primary education, 35 girls continue with secondary education, 1 continue with High school

TAILORING TRAINING:

A total of 37 girls received vocational and entrepreneurship skills at the Safe Houses. On the tailoring Class the following were taught.

- Girls managed to learn the method of measuring clothing and its dimensions.
- Type of the clothing.
- How to sew skirts in vibrant colours.
- How to do maintenance of the sew machine



FORMAL EDUCATION: [PRIMARY, SECONDARY]

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

1. FIT PERSON TRAINING

Fit persons training was conducted to 57 people from Butiama, Serengeti and Tarime, these people will help protect children against the law under supervision of Social welfare.



2. GRADUATION FOR VOCATIONAL TRAINING GIRLS

We had graduation of our girls at Butiama Safe House whereby 9 girls graduated from a tailoring class. Hope for Girls and Women in Tanzania offered the 9 sewing machines to graduates



3. ARP CEREMONY

The Graduation Ceremony was conducted to girls whom graduated from Tailoring class at the safe house in Butiama, Where Government leaders, community leaders, Influential people, some parents attended. Nine Girls were gifted with Sewing machines.

4. Providing a safe and healthy environment for girls from FGM and other forms of violence

Health check-up conducted to girls who arrived in both safe houses, this conducted in collaboration with police gender desk and social welfare. All girls had health check. Health services were provided to all children whom found with health problems after check up to the hospital were treated. Counselling sessions conducted to all girls. Medication to sick girls was done too. Food and basic needs were provided.

5. GIRLS RESCUE CAMP PROGRAMMES AND RECONCILIATION

The reconciliation work continues in collaboration with Police gender desk officers, Social welfare and Hope staff. Total of 7 girls were reconciled
